



If heading East on I-470, exit at the Douglas/Colbern Exit 9 and follow the signs for 291-South which will take you left onto Douglas at the top of the exit ramp, then right onto Colbern Rd and then right onto 291-South. Get in the right lane and go through the light at Mulberry St, turn right immediately after the Fairfield Inn onto NE Deerbrook Street. Turn left onto Windsor Dr and then turn right into the third entrance to the parking lot of the Windsor Park complex. Facial Spectrum is on the left # 1208.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL PATIENTS

Bring a list of all medications you are taking:

If you use an inhaler bring it with you.

Call the office prior to your appointment, if:

- you normally take antibiotics prior to your appointments,
- you take medications for diabetes (especially insulin),
- you take a blood thinner (Coumadin).

A parent / legal guardian must accompany minor children (under 18 years old).

PATIENTS WHO MIGHT RECEIVE GENERAL ANESTHESIA

MORNING APPOINTMENT: DO NOT eat or drink anything, including water and coffee, after midnight the night before your appointment. *It is usually ok to take your routine morning blood pressure / heart / thyroid medication or antibiotics with a slp of water. Call if you have questions regarding your medications.

FOR PATIENTS WITH APPOINTMENTS AFTER 1:00 p.m.: Before 5:00 a.m., you may have one glass of juice, one slice of toast with jelly. (No milk, butter, fat, protein.) You may drink water before 5:00 a.m. **ABSOLUTELY NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER 5:00 a.m., including water and coffee.** *It is usually ok to take your routine oral medications with a slp of water.

If instructions are not followed, you may not be able to have sedation and may have surgery rescheduled.

A responsible adult needs to accompany you to your appointment, drive you home and stay with you for 6-8 hours following surgery.

Wear glasses or bring a storage case for your contact lenses.

Wear loose, comfortable clothing with sleeves that can be raised above your elbow. Wear low-heeled shoes and if possible avoid open-heeled shoes.
